



## A UNIFIED BODY FOR TARGET SHOOTING

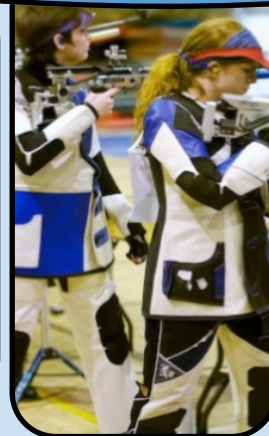
In partnership with its members, Scottish Target Shooting has drawn up plans for creating a single, unified Scottish governing body. A full proposal detailing the membership, governance and financial structure has now been released and is available to all. This leaflet provides a summary, explaining how the proposed changes to STS will benefit the sport and have a positive impact on clubs and individuals involved in all disciplines and at all levels across Scotland.



# THE BENEFITS OF JOINING STS

## TARGET SHOOTING

- As a unified body, STS can provide a stronger collective voice to better represent the views of Scots involved in the sport
- Investment by sportscotland in STS has grown from £10k to £75k with the opportunity to apply for further development funding
- STS has already secured an additional £25k of project funding from sportscotland to support over 30 people gain their coaching qualifications and STS to develop a new membership system
- STS has secured a commitment from the Scottish Government to invest in a new National Shooting Centre
- STS have acquired a dedicated office, administrator, bookkeeper and senior officer to support the development of all disciplines
